


## The venue



The SPIRIT Workshop will be held in the Conference Room of the Great Mosque of Rome, in Italy.
The address is **Viale della Moschea**, 85, 00197 Rome.



There are several public transport options to get to the mosque. The best option is to reach the 'Flaminio' metro station and take the Roma-Viterbo train, get off at the 'Campi Sportivi' stop and then walk 350 metres to the Grand Mosque. Please kindly note that the 'Campi Sportivi' station is as optional stop for the train and needs to be reserved by pressing a red button inside the train. 'Monte Antenne', the following train stop, is however close to the mosque, in case you miss the 'Campi Sportivi' station.



Another option is to take bus 360 from any of the stations served by the line (which departs from 'Termini' station) and get off at the 'Salvini' stop and then walk for about 10 minutes.
